BACKGROUND

Adam McGuire earned a Bachelor of Science in Landscape Architecture from Pennsylvania State University in 2007. Prior to and during his studies, Mr. McGuire worked as a landscape designer and contractor, a job that led him to the profession of landscape architecture. During his time in school, he was very active in the Landscape Architecture Student Society (LASS) and served as Treasurer during his senior year after returning from studying abroad in Italy. During that time, he organized several fund-raisers and initiated a program of informational sessions taught by industry professionals, as well as headed an effort to publish a book celebrating the 100th anniversary of Penn State's Landscape Architecture Department. He received several awards from the department for his involvement and commitment to the profession.

Mr. McGuire first came to Florida as a summer intern with EDSA and returned to EDSA upon graduation after a separate internship at a large multi-disciplinary firm. During his time with EDSA, he has worked as a planner and registered landscape architect on a variety of projects throughout Florida, the Caribbean, and the Middle East. His responsibilities have included planting design, detailed design, project management and client relations. Mr. McGuire has also been very active in the local chapter of ULI's Young Leaders and is currently assisting with program development for that group. Additionally, he serves as a volunteer youth soccer coach in the local Fort Lauderdale community.
